FIVE HOTELS WHERE TWO WHEELS ARE PART OF THE DEAL BY DAVID HOWARD

h2hotel // Healdsburg, California

The stylish Sonoma retreat is quintessential California, from the environmental ethos (a plant-covered “green” roof and reclaimed building materials are among highlights) to the surrounding wine country to the fleet of elegant Public Bikes, built down the road in San Francisco. The hotel provides four mapped routes to

pedal them on, ranging from 12 to 40 miles, with vineyard stops along the way. *From \$195/night*

Mansion Hill Inn // Madison, Wisconsin

Trek purchased this stately Victorian inn five years ago and subtly superimposed its brand during an otherwise faithful historical restoration. Framed vintage photos

of its early models hang alongside contemporary images of sponsored riders like Fabian Cancellara. The hotel provides passes to Madison’s B-cycle bike share, but why settle? Guests can request a spin on any bike Trek makes, free. *From \$200/night*

Sorrel River Ranch Resort & Spa // Near Moab, Utah

A sprawling launch pad for

the legendary White Rim Trail, Sorrel River caters to the knobby-tire crowd. Use its dedicated maintenance station to give your bike a little TLC after a day of riding Moab’s sun-baked terrain. Then treat yourself to its signature slickrock massage, designed to relieve cycling-specific muscles. In keeping with the trail-centric motif, the bar serves goathead martinis in homage to the tread-shredding thorns that proliferate in canyon country. *From \$399/night*

Bowery House // New York City

It’s not just the custom Dutch-style bicycles for rent that make this newly restored hybrid of a hotel and a flophouse museum interesting—even though the upright rides allow you to roll around the bike-friendly Lower East Side in Euro-style comfort. And it’s not just the landscaped garden roof. It’s also the virtually unheard-of-for-Manhattan prices: Rates average \$84 a night for a private room, flophouse-style cabin, or dorm-type bunk bed. *From \$79/night*

Shore Lodge // McCall, Idaho

These being the Salmon River Mountains, there’s action at every turn, from the lift-serviced runs at Brundage Mountain to the mellow trails at Ponderosa State Park. **Shore Lodge** outfits you for any adventure with Trek Fuel X mountain bike rentals; afterward, you’re steps away from a restorative dip in cool Payette Lake. Feel like going easier? The hotel offers a fleet of town bikes, gratis, for a meander around McCall, home to the Salmon River Brewery. *From \$119/night*

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
