The Concierge Service: Mountain Bike Fitting

For a truly immersive mountain biking experience, the concierge at Shore Lodge in McCall, Idaho fits their guests with state-of-the-art Trek Fuel EX 6 bikes before sending them off on a guided tour of Payette backcountry. Bike trails range in difficulty from advanced beginner (3000-foot descent through glacier carved walls of Lick Creek Canyon to the base of the South Salmon River) to advanced (20-mile trail trek which can include a stop at the Burgdorf Hotsprings).
