

Top Resort Destinations with Airports to Fly Private

As the height of summer travel continues, thousands of delayed and canceled flights, employee-strikes and lost bags have stalled vacationers. For those able to splurge this year (and those traveling in large groups, flying private has become an increasingly popular alternative to commercial travel. Shore Lodge | McCall, Idaho

Located just a five-minute drive from Shore Lodge & Whitetail Club, the McCall Municipal Airport, known as "The Gateway to Backcountry," is a full-service airport offering one runway and servicing over 40,000 flights each year. Aircrafts ranging from small general aviation (GA) aircraft to larger turbine-powered aircraft and business jets regularly operate from McCall. Private flyers have the luxury of leasing their own hangar, should they need one (size permitting). Shore Lodge is an award-winning lakefront resort located in McCall, Idaho – the heart of the region's prized Salmon River Mountains and one of the best hidden ski towns to visit in 2016 as designated by National Geographic. The remote destination located just 2.5 hours outside of Boise provides off-the-beaten path understated, small town luxury and onlyhere backcountry adventures.
